

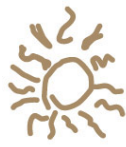


# Grounds for Change

*The Calgary Zoo's Schoolyard Naturalization Program*

## *Edmonton Public Schools*

<b><i>Belgravia School</i></b>	older project includes pond, raised beds with vegetables, native plantings, signage, sundial (see Evergreen Project Registry)
<b><i>Dunluce School</i></b>	native plantings, murals, seating, signage
<b><i>Ellerslie Campus</i></b>	6 year old project; includes pond, wetland habitat, native plantings; signage; wildlife structures (see Evergreen Project Registry)
<b><i>Forest Heights School</i></b>	expressed an interest in the concept, may plan something small
<b><i>George H. Luck School</i></b>	project 5 years old; large area; native plantings; study circle; some issues with weeds
<b><i>Glenora School</i></b>	fairly well established; benches, picnic tables, native plantings
<b><i>Holyrood School</i></b>	small project at front of school; colourful native and non-native plantings; poetry circle, stump seating, semi-circle seating under tree (made from recycled futon materials), tree 'cookies' used in pathways
<b><i>Ormsby Elementary School</i></b>	courtyard garden with pond; fenced in; located behind the school
<b><i>Riverdale Elementary School</i></b>	features raised beds, creative signage, grass labyrinth, rain barrel, log benches

## ***Edmonton Catholic Schools***

<b><i>St. Boniface Elementary School</i></b>	elaborate project incorporating play structures, split rail fences, paved pathways, raised beds, painted stepping stones, park-grade changeable signage, wooden bridge structures, large sand play pits, dry river bed, extensive native plantings
<b><i>St. Jerome Elementary School</i></b>	
<b><i>St. Mary Elementary School</i></b>	Secret Garden; part of project in fenced area; composters, stump seating, log benches; three sisters garden; tried a labyrinth painted onto recycled tire paving
<b><i>St. Nicholas Junior High School</i></b>
